



Description of the Program:

The Financial Assistance Program, as sponsored by Union Hospital of Cecil County, offers services at a reduced cost based on a patient's inability to pay.

This program insures that a consistent and equitable process is utilized to grant financial assistance to appropriate patients while respecting the individual's dignity.

New and Expanded Features:

Although Union Hospital has provided financial assistance in the past, this new and expanded program will provide the following additions:

- Balances are adjusted based on Federal poverty Guidelines – tiered up to a 100% adjustment. Previously the adjustments were tiered up to 50%, so this change will permit us to provide more financial assistance to those we serve
- Extended financial assistance eligibility for a six-month period from the date of approval, rather than former practice of just considering the charges associated with current services rendered.

Who is Eligible?

If you are underinsured or uninsured, the Union Hospital Financial Assistance Program is designed to help eliminate your fear and anxiety regarding your medical bills. Determination of probable eligibility will be made within two (2) business days of your request for financial assistance. The application procedure is simple and straightforward. To see if you qualify, just follow the guidelines below:

Guidelines for applying:

The first step is to complete a Financial Assistance Application and provide the following supportive documentation:

- Copies of pay stubs, unemployment benefits, social security checks, cash assistance checks, alimony or child support checks
- Provide a copy of Federal or State tax returns
- Share actual bank statements or financial records to verify assets & income
- Produce written verification of active residence
- Supply copy of Medical Assistance Denial letter

When all information is completed and validated, a Financial Counselor will review your information then provide you with a final determination of eligibility.
