The Patient Health Portal is an online tool that goes a step beyond simply displaying information by helping you manage your health-care easily and securely.

What information can be found on the Portal?

All of the information in the Portal comes from your Union Hospital Electronic Health Record. This ensures that you have access to the most accurate, up-to-date information possible.

How do I log into the Portal?

To log into the Portal, visit the Patient Portal link on www.uhcc.com. Then, simply enter your user name and password. Ask for printed instructions or view online on the Patient Portal link.

Can my family access my Portal?

Yes, you can give anyone, such as parents or healthcare proxies, access to your Portal. This needs to be done within your healthcare facility and requires consent from you.

Is my information safe?

Yes. Portal passwords are encrypted and URLs are re-written so that they cannot be copied and pasted. You and authorized viewers are the only ones who can access your Portal. Also, a timeout feature protects your information if you leave the Portal page open.
